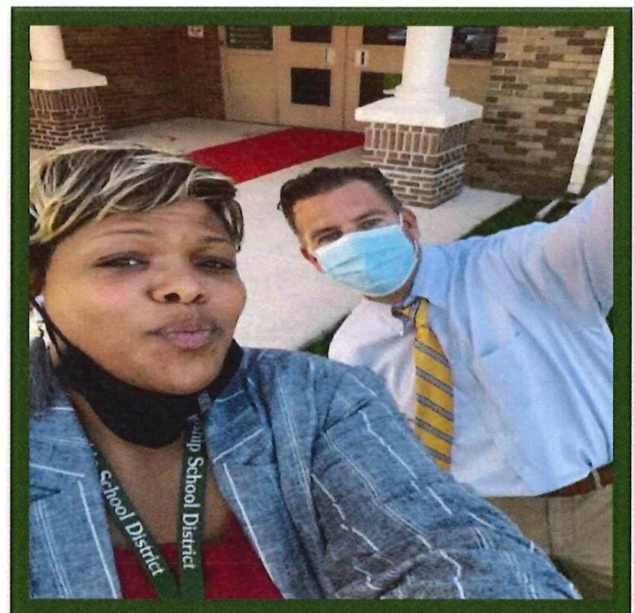
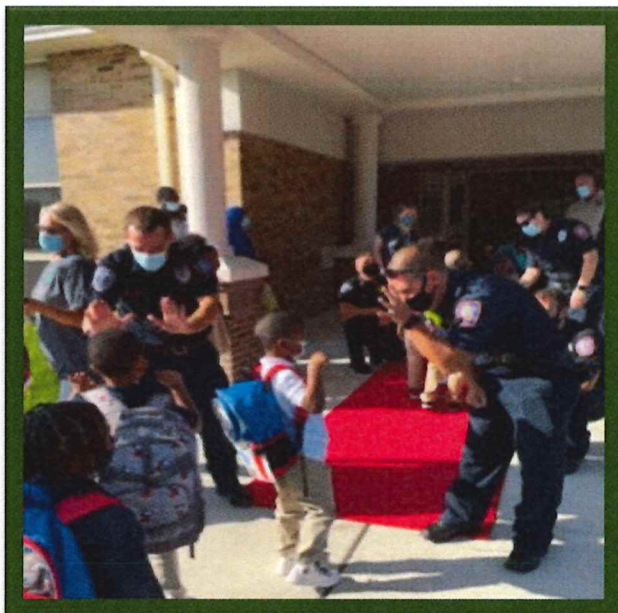
OPENING DAY FOR STAFF 9/1/21

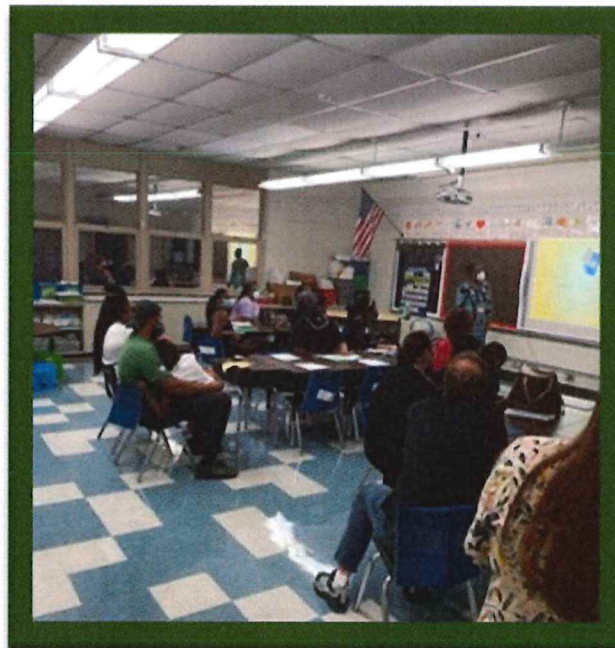
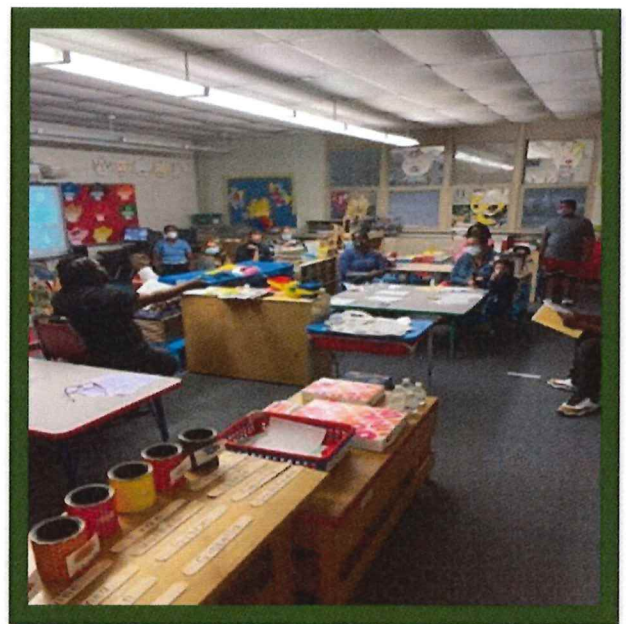
FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL 9/7/21

The Home & School Association began the Miss Chocolate fundraiser during the month of September, encouraging students to sell candy by offering them great incentives.

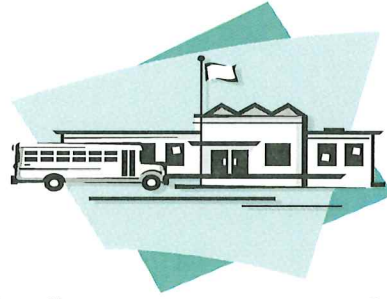
