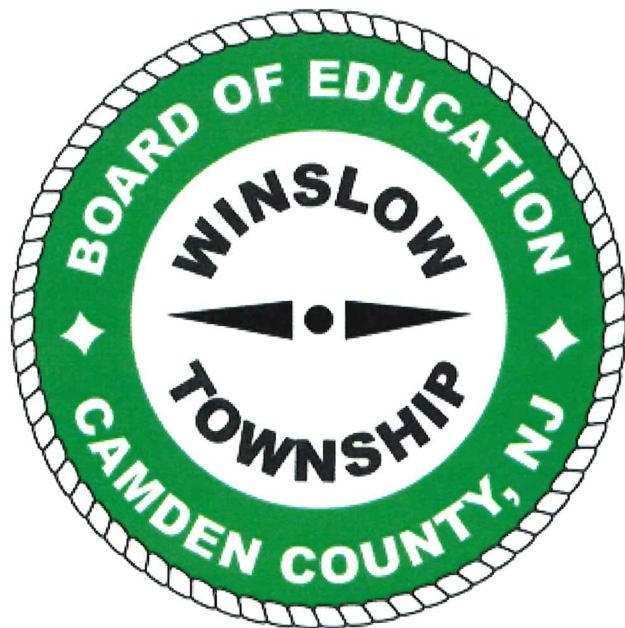

Interim Report cards were sent home on March 11th.

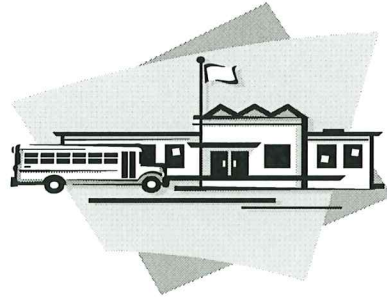
On March 22nd, School 5 hosted our annual 4th Grade Family Fun Night. Fourth grade students and their families participated in an evening of fun and competition.

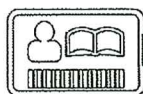
AP Exams

Bringing Hollywood to NJ

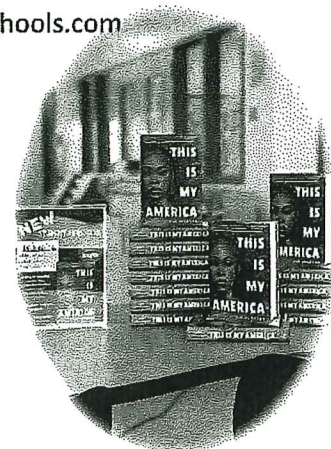
