Foat III, class of 2019, who distinguished himself by outstanding achievement while assigned to 96th Security Forces Squadron, 96th Mission Support Group, 96th Test Wing, Eglin Air Force Base, Florida. During this period, Airman Foat led base entry control, where he prevented unauthorized access to the installation. "Without hesitation, he deployed the emergency barriers and alerted backup forces to respond within three seconds, posturing final denial efforts and shielding 71.4 thousand personnel and 6.1 billion dollars in resources." 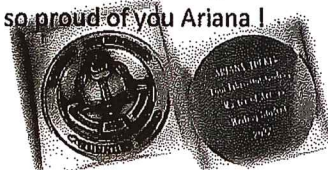
Congratulations to WTHS's alumni Airman First Class Cleveland A. Foat III, class of 2019, who distinguished himself by outstanding achievement while assigned to 96th Security Forces Squadron, 96th Mission Support Group, 96th Test Wing, Eglin Air Force Base, Florida. During this period, Airman Foat led base entry control, where he prevented unauthorized access to the installation.



"Without hesitation, he deployed the emergency barriers and alerted backup forces to respond within three seconds, posturing final denial efforts and shielding 71.4 thousand personnel and 6.1 billion dollars in resources." Additionally, he closed base access to the affected area solidifying containment and potential follow-on intrusion attempts, while re-routing 350 vehicles away from the scene. Furthermore, Airman Foat's actions resulted in four illegal individuals being charged with trespassing, and primed four federal agencies in initiating a smuggling investigation. Finally, Airman Foat's leadership foiled an intrusion attempt to the base and deported four subjects out of the country within 24 hours. The distinctive accomplishments of Airman Foat reflect credit upon himself and the United States Air Force. Wow! The WTHS family salute your achievements!

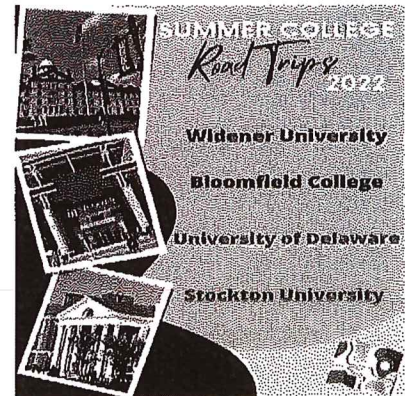

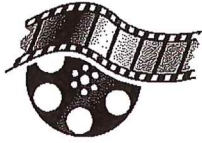
