WHEREAS, the normal requirements of the law regarding 48-hours' notice has not been met due to lack of time and urgency of the subject matter; however, notices of this emergency meeting were forwarded, via facsimile and e-mail, to the Camden Courier Post and the Atlantic City Press on August 15, 2023 at 10:15 am; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the meeting is to address an ongoing crisis to provide critically needed Teacher Classroom Assistants, Educational Student One-on-One Aides, Educational Bus Aides, and Before and After Childcare Program Supervisors & Aides that may impact the operations of the School District and the delay of such a meeting may create a greater, more significant impact on the WTBOE's operations and the need for adequate notice could not reasonably have been foreseen at a time when adequate notice could have been provided.

WHEREAS, detailed specifications were completed and bids were properly advertised by the Winslow Township Board of Education ("WTBOE" and/or "Board") for Teacher Classroom Assistants, Educational Student One-on-One Aides, Educational Bus Aides, and Before and After School Childcare Program Supervisors & Aides on two (2) occasions, as Bid 2023-08 and Bid 2024-01; and

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WHEREAS, on both occasions, the remaining apparent low bidder was ESS Support Services, LLC ("ESS") with a 37.5% markup for all positions, which would result in a total cost to the WTBOE of \$4,959,900.00; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Tyra McCoy-Boyle, Business Administrator/Board Secretary on behalf of the WTBOE advised that the Board has appropriated \$4,282,677.00 for this contract, thereby making ESS's bid \$677,223.00 above the Board's appropriated amount on both occasions; and

WHEREAS, the bids were rejected by the WTBOE on both occasions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-22(b) and, on the second occasion, as bids had been advertised on two (2) occasions and the WTBOE has rejected such bids on both occasions because it had determined that the bids are not reasonable as to price, the WTBOE authorized the negotiation of the contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-5(c); and

WHEREAS, negotiations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-5(c) occurred for the Teacher Classroom Assistants, Educational Student One-on-One Aides, Educational Bus Aides, and Before and After School Childcare Program Supervisors & Aides, including an in-person session held on August 14, 2023, which resulted in an agreement with ESS in the form attached hereto and made apart hereof; and

WHEREAS, the WTBOE desires to authorize the award of the contract for Teacher Classroom Assistants, Educational Student One-on-One Aides, Educational Bus Aides, and Before and After School Childcare Program Supervisors & Aides to ESS in the form attached hereto and made apart hereof, subject to review by the WTBOE Solicitor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Winslow Township Board of Education as follows:

- 1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
- 2. The contract for Teacher Classroom Assistants, Educational Student One-on-One Aides, Educational Bus Aides, and Before and After School Childcare Program Supervisors & Aides on behalf of the Winslow Township Board of Education is hereby awarded to ESS Support Services, LLC in the form attached hereto and made apart hereof, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-5(c), subject to review by the WTBOE Solicitor.
- 3. The Board Administrator and/or her designee are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate award the contract for Teacher Classroom Assistants, Educational Student One-on-One Aides, Educational Bus Aides, and Before and After School Childcare Program Supervisors & Aides to ESS Support Services, LLC, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-5(c), subject to review by the WTBOE Solicitor.
