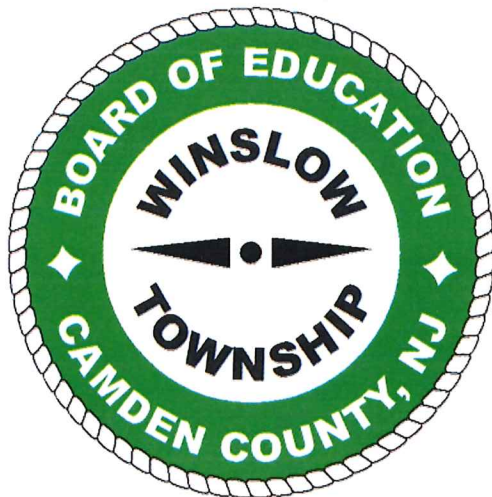

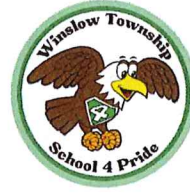

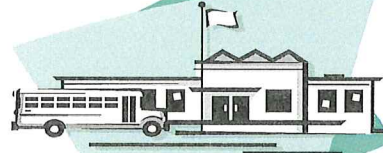

Voorhees Animal Orphanage



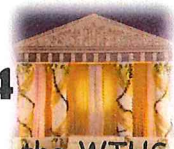
