February 21<sup>st</sup> was our second Renaissance Happening, all students that made the Renaissance were able to bring in snacks and play games in the cafeteria.

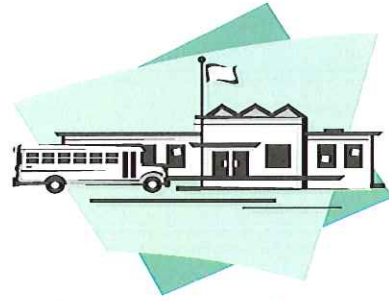

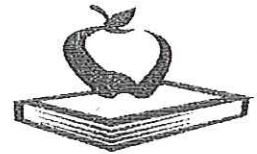
