April Highlights 2014

April 3rd- First Grade Fun Fest-Evening physical fitness program designed for first grade students and their families to participate and interact in fitness activities encouraging family involvement and healthy competition and fitness. Physical Education Student of the Year semi-finalists third grade students were selected as helpers for the program.

April 3rd- PARCC Field Test-Participation in the NJ State PARCC field test in mathematics in two third grade classrooms, requiring students to take the electronic assessment on desktop computers and chromebooks.

April 4th-PJs and Read a Good Book day-Staff and students wore pajamas to school and read a "good book" throughout the day.

April 8th-Writing with Spice-third grade-Mike DeVono-EIRC writing presenter provided a series of in class writing lessons for third grade classes, focus on writing strategies and test taking strategies. Presenter meeting/workshop for third grade teachers, Reading Specialist and Principal to receive direct information regarding instructional strategies, test taking strategies, review of student writing samples and writing instruction.

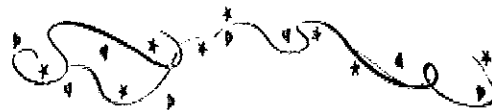
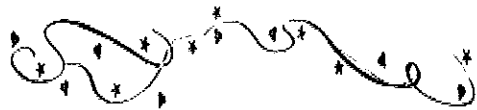

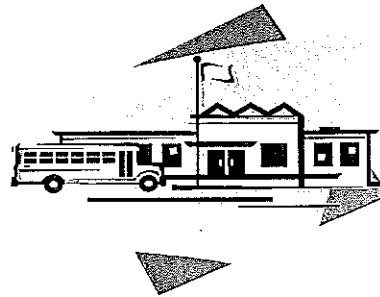
April 29th, was our annual chorus concert. All participants did an outstanding job.

 - The April Manner Banner was awarded to Mrs. Serratore's class.

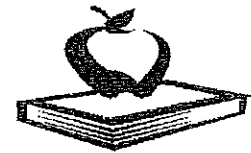

In March, Winslow Township High School students attended a very important and life-changing program through Cooper University Hospital. These students took part in Cooper Hospital's Traumatic Injury Prevention Program. This program enlightens students on the dangers related to poor judgment, drug and alcohol use, gang relations and violence. Students gained firsthand experience in the trauma unit, took part in a powerful lesson on risk-taking behaviors, went on a tour of the Trauma Intensive Care Unit and actually witnessed a helicopter bringing in a patient while in the Trauma ER. The lessons learned that day were powerful enough to last a lifetime, moved the students deeply and will hopefully keep them safe in the future.

The WTHS Indoor Guard successfully completed its second competitive season in the Cavalcade of Bands Indoor Circuit with a spectacular show titled Take Me To The Water, which was written by Jessica Dixon, an alumni of Winslow Township High School, and based on Alvin Ailey's famous production Wade in the Water. Indoor Color Guard is a combination of dance and theatrics while spinning flags, rifles and sabres. During its season, WTHS Indoor Guard went to six different competitions with eight performers: Captain Kaela Pone, Christah Blackwell, Morel Bullock, Treasure Cary, Mahogany Durant, Shanice Flournoy, Abigail Joanis and Johneta Williams. They placed second with an average score of 91.98 at the Cavalcade of Bands Indoor Guard Novice Championship. This is the highest score ever achieved by the WTHS Indoor Guard. They outscored 24 other guards who competed in this circuit. WTHS Indoor Guard has accumulated many fans from other schools and communities with their upbeat music, high-intensity movements, theatrics and positive attitude. They have also gained the respect and interest of many judges throughout the Cavalcade circuit. Guard Captain Kaela Pone was awarded a full scholarship towards extensive training in a Color Guard summer program. She was also recognized for her exceptional leadership skills. Congratulations to the WTHS Indoor Guard on another great season.

The arrival of spring signals the busiest time of the year for Winslow Township High School's Environmental Club. On the first day of spring, students went to the Omni Recycling Facility in Pitman where club members had a chance to see the process behind single stream recycling, a method used throughout Camden County. Then, students travelled to the Popcorn Park Zoo in Forked River, NJ. Affiliated with the Humane Society, the Popcorn Park Zoo is a facility that takes in and fosters animals that are in distress, neglected or destined for canned hunts. As part of the club members' "entry fee," students were required to bring items such as old blankets, cleaning supplies or dog/cat treats for donation. The final trip of the year was to Ocean City, NJ. As part of the Adopt-a-Beach Program, students participated in two beach clean ups: one at the beginning of the year and one at the end. 13th street in Ocean City hosts a sign which denotes it as an area adopted and maintained by Winslow Township High School Environmental Club.
