HSA also opened Winslow Township School #5 store on September 19<sup>th</sup>. Students were able to purchase items for themselves as well as family and friends.

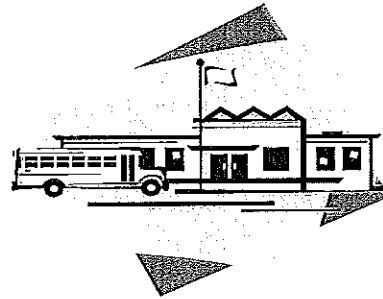

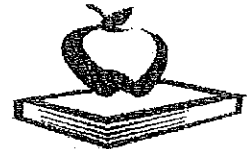
