January 6th -PARCC Parent Workshop-Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers Family Workshop presented by the Winslow Twp. School District to provide important assessment preparation information parents of third grade students preparing to take the PARCC assessment in March 2015.

January 6th -School Safety Committee meeting-School One Safety Committee meeting to discuss any issues/concerns/updates regarding School One.

January 8th -Writing with Spice-embedded classroom writing lessons for third grade students and teachers, provided by Mike DaVono, EIRC's Writing with Spice.

January 12th -Buffalo Bills Take Out Night-HSA sponsored fundraising event for School One students and their families to purchase food from a local community eatery/restaurant to support the School One student activities and programs.

January 15th -Dental Health Presentations-grade level dental health presentation provided on site at School One, to encourage and develop proper dental and nutrition habits provided by the Dental Health Association of New Jersey

January 16th -Third Grade Team meeting-third grade teachers and staff meeting to review and analyze data, discuss student RTI progress and progress monitoring, PARCC preparation and instructional strategies.

January 21st -Monthly Faculty meeting-regularly scheduled monthly staff meetings attended by the Building Principal and School One staff

During the month of January

A is for Applebee's- academic program providing incentives for students to achieve academic excellence and/or effort, rewarding certificates for meals and various food items.

RTI-Response to Intervention-students receive daily RTI instruction in kindergarten through third grades, at their specific learning level from low struggling to advanced learners.

Shining Star Rewards-tickets awarded to students exemplifying positive behaviors, earning a weekly prize announced after an end of the day Name Drawing.

Words of the Day-third grade students announce higher level vocabulary writing and math words and phrases as part of the morning daily announcements. The words of the day and students names are displayed in the front foyer of the school building.

Artist of the Month-Each art class, first through third grades are awarded "Mona Lisa Art Buckaroo points for displaying "art studio" behavior expectations and following "art studio rules". Winners receive a certificate, their photo on the award wall and a choice of pencil or sketchbook.

I&RS-Intervention and Referral Services-I7RS meetings used to discuss and review student data and performance of students struggling behaviorally or academically.

Perfecting Church Perfecting Chords Afterschool Music Program-Every Monday a local community church, The Perfecting Church, to introduce the musical/instrumental program after school for students, preschool through third grades, on site at School One.

Emergency /Safety Drills-regularly scheduled monthly emergency/safety drills conducted across the District to ensure the safety of all staff and students in the event of an actual emergency.

Parent/Principal meetings-Parent/Teacher/Principal meetings-meetings to discuss student discipline, classroom concerns, peer issues or conflicts, instructional needs and student data.

Principal's Meetings-Principal's attendance at regularly scheduled Principals meetings.

Meetings with District ELA and Math Supervisors to determine the instructional needs of students in preschool through third grades, curriculum and instruction common core alignment and third grade student PARCC preparation.

Regular HSA meetings-monthly Home and School Association meetings to support communication between home, school and community, plan events and discuss upcoming School One activities.

ESD Tutoring-Extended School Day Tutoring-Afterschool tutoring provided for School One students, Monday through Thursday.

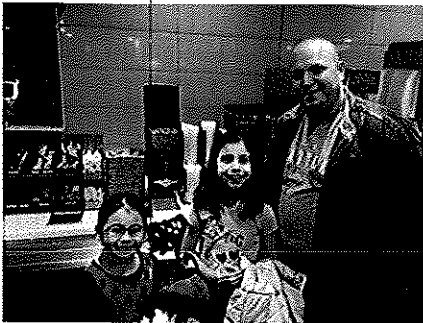
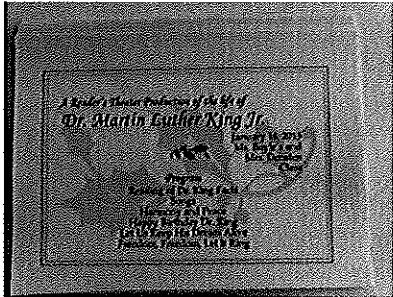

No Name Calling Week

The week of January 20-23 was School #4's Third Annual No Name Calling Week. Counselor Laura Duca, conducted classroom and building level activities, including an assembly on January 23, 2015.

To get everyone more involved in the spirit of the week, Mrs. Duca conducted lessons for each class by reading the books listed below. A short lesson was done in the beginning, followed by a brief discussion. Each class then completed an appropriate theme-related activity and also took part in signing the "No Name-Calling Week Pledge". The lessons/activities were as follows:

- Pre-School/Kindergarten - We read "Stand Tall, Molly Lou Melon" by Todd Parr. After reading the story, they discussed how important it is to be proud of yourself. They also received a "name tag" to decorate in a very unique way.

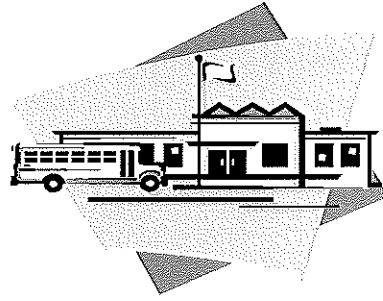
