

2312 CLASS SIZE

The Board of Education recognizes the relatedness of staffing goals, staff utilization, class size and effective teaching. Accordingly, the Board delegates to the Superintendent the task of providing adequate staff and classes to accommodate the needs of the pupils.

Minimum Class Size

An enrollment of fifteen pupils shall be necessary in order to establish any class as part of the school program. Exceptions to this procedure are those regulated by New Jersey Administrative Code and regulations: State Compensatory Education, Chapter I, Special Education, Vocational Education Programs and Preschool Programs.

Courses Requiring Superintendent's Approval

Classes, with an anticipated enrollment of ten to fourteen pupils, may be recommended by the Principal to the Superintendent for inclusion in the school's master schedule.

Courses Requiring Approval by the Board of Education

Classes with an anticipated enrollment of less than ten pupils may be recommended by the Superintendent to the Board of Education for inclusion in the school's master schedule.
