Dennis Young - President, Winslow Township Basketball Association

Mr. Young stated that he had a scheduled meeting with Dr. Poteat on December 17, 2009 but wanted to speak publicly regarding the Winslow Township Basketball Association's use of Winslow schools for practices and games. Over 300 children participate in the program and they use School # 1, # 5, # 6, Middle and High Schools every night/5 days week from 6 – 9 p.m. and School # 5, # 6, Middle and High Schools on Saturday. He asked the Board to reconsider their decision to enforce the policy in place, but never previously enforced, by charging groups for their use of Winslow schools on weekends because the school district has to pay overtime for their custodial staff to be at the schools.

Dr. Poteat responded that it is costly for the district and for the past three years the district has paid \$300,000.00, \$255,000.00 and so far this year \$132,000.00 in overtime to custodial staff.
