### 4. Inter-District Public School Choice Program Act

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF THE WINSLOW TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION RESTRICTING THE ENROLLMENT OF ITS STUDENTS IN CHOICE SCHOOL DISTRICTS PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 18A:36B-1 ET SEQ.

**WHEREAS,** N.J.S.A. 18A:36B-1 et seq. is known as the "Interdistrict Public School Choice Program Act" and was originally enacted by P.L. 1999 Chapter 413 ("Act"); and,

WHEREAS, the Act was recently amended by P.L. 2010, Chapter 65 ("Amendment"); and,

**WHEREAS**, the Amendment to the Act permits school districts to adopt a resolution to restrict the enrollment of its students in a Choice School District; and,

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**WHEREAS**, the Winslow Township Board of Education has determined that restricting enrollment of its students in a Choice School District is in the best interest of the Winslow Township School District's students because of the adverse impact on programs, services operations and fiscal conditions, as well as diversity of the students of the school district.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winslow Township Board of Education that pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Amendment to the Act, the number of students of the Winslow Township School District eligible to be enrolled in a Choice School District is hereby restricted as follows:

1. No more than ten (10%) percent of the number of students per grade level per year may be enrolled in a Choice School District.

This Resolution shall be subject to the approval by the Commissioner of Education and/or his/her designee as required pursuant to the Amendment to the Act.
